Commemorative Site Information

St. Joseph Apartments are located in the Frontier area of West 6th Street in Erie. The beautiful, historical building has 204 apartments for senior citizens and persons with disabilities who can live independently.

Brookside Apartments are located in Meadville, PA. This complex for senior citizens is located along a picturesque little creek called Mill Run that runs through town, creating a parklike setting all around.

Chestnut Street Apartments are located in Fairview, PA. The facility was the first, large-scale affordable housing complex in this west county community. It was fashioned from a 1920's high school and features 29 one-bedroom and 16 two-bedroom apartments for senior citizens.

Oak Haven Apartments are located in Waterford, PA. This new facility was built to resemble a large, family homestead reflective of the charming architecture found in many of the town's homes. It has 22 apartments for senior citizens.

Better Homes for Erie is a well-kept downtown block of townhouses for 30 low-income families in Erie. The development is owned by the local Catholic Diocese and managed by HANDS.
